

Toshiba announces its first ever Freeview+ HD Digital TV Recorder

London, UK, 10th February 2010 – Toshiba UK today introduces its first ever Digital TV Recorder (DTR) capable of displaying and recording Freeview HD broadcasts – the HDR5010. Building on Toshiba's strong reputation within the DVD sector, the model is set to be the first in a range of Freeview+ HD products from Toshiba, with more to follow later this year.

The smart, glossy black unit allows users to view and record live television in high definition, ensuring they never miss an episode of their favourite show. Dual-digital tuners also allow users to watch one channel while recording another, offering the ultimate in flexible HD viewing. The DTR also features an internal eight day television guide, allowing users to easily plan their viewing, as well as built-in Audio Description capability for visually impaired users.

As well as viewing, recording, pausing and rewinding live high-definition television, users are able to store up to 120 hours of HD content on an internal 500GB hard drive. An entire television series or multiple films can be recorded at the touch of a button, providing the ability to create a personal entertainment library suited to each individual user's tastes.

The inclusion of two integrated USB ports enable users to view images straight on to their television, as well as allowing for feature and software upgrades. MP3s can also be played

directly from USB flash memory sticks, with further support for the popular DivX video format offering additional ways to enjoy digital video.

The new HDR5010 features two HDMI inputs, providing a lossless way to connect to HD ready TVs, or peripheral HD devices including camcorders, games consoles or Blu-ray players. Users can also take advantage of new digital interactive features via the integrated Ethernet port.
